

## Overview: Reopening of Campus

These guidelines may change, therefore we recommend checking our Facebook or website “COVID update” page for new or changing information. If at any time a resident or an employee becomes positive we must return to Phase I and start the process over.

### Assisted Living Facility Visitation and IL Use of Campus AL Amenities

#### 1. Phase I

- Visitation prohibited, except for compassionate care situations. In those limited situation, visitors are screened and additional precautions are taken, including social distancing, and hand hygiene (e.g., use alcohol based hand rub upon entry and exit of the facility). All visitors must wear a mask (face covering) for the duration of their visit.
- Dining room meals are limited to AL residents who are asymptomatic or tested negative for the infection, with social distancing.

#### 2. Phase II

- Visitation is generally prohibited in ALF except for compassionate care.
- Independent living residents on campus may utilize the dining room and beauty shop services after being screened.
- All must wear a mask (face covering) for the duration of their visit and report directly to the intended destination.
- Dining room meals are limited to AL and IL residents who are asymptomatic or have tested negative for the infection, with social distancing.

#### 3. Phase III

- Visitation is allowed by appointment for ALF residents in a designated visitation area, and not on a residential unit.
- All visitors and Independent Living residents are screened and additional precautions are taken, including social distancing, and hand hygiene (e.g., use alcohol based hand rub upon entry and exit of the facility), and the use of a mask/face covering.
- IL residents may only enter for dining services and beauty shop services.
- Dining room meals are limited to the asymptomatic ALF or IL residents or to those who have tested negative, with social distancing.

#### 4. Phase IV

- **Visitation is allowed for AL residents by appointment in a resident’s room**, provided screening criteria are met and the visitor continually honors masking and social distancing. If failure to follow instruction is noted, the visitor will be asked to leave.
- All visitors and IL residents entering will be screened and must wear a mask (face covering) for the duration of their visit.
- Dining room meals and group activities are limited to AL and IL residents with social distancing for those who are asymptomatic or have tested negative of the infection.

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### **Nursing Facility Visitation During Each Phase**

**Note: Each phase is a minimum of 14 days, and based on numerous other criteria set forth by state and Federal guidelines. If at any time a resident or an employee becomes positive we must return to Phase I and start the process over. These guidelines may change, therefore we recommend checking our Facebook or website “COVID update” page for new or changing information.**

#### **1. Phase I & Phase II**

- Visitation is generally prohibited, except for compassionate care situations. In those limited situation, visitors are screened and additional precautions are taken, including social distancing, and hand hygiene (e.g., use alcohol based hand rub upon entry and exit of the facility). All visitors must wear a mask (face covering) for the duration of their visit.

#### **2. Phase III & Phase IV**

- Visitation is allowed by screening, appointment, and additional precautions, including social distancing, and hand hygiene (e.g., use alcohol based hand rub upon entry and exit of the facility).
- All entering must wear a mask (face covering) for the duration of their visit. Visits will be made in a designated visitation area and not on a residential unit, as determined by administration in relation to community and/or state infection risk. Those who fail to comply will be asked to leave.

#### **3. Phase V**

- Visitation is allowed by appointment in designated visitation rooms, but not on the resident’s clinical units (i.e. not in resident rooms) unless the resident has a private room and the visitor reports directly to the private room.
- All visitors are screened and additional precautions are taken, including social distancing, and hand hygiene (e.g., use alcohol based hand rub upon entry and exit of the facility). All entering must wear a mask (face covering) for the duration of their visit.
- Visitors must continually honor masking and social distancing. Those who fail to comply will be asked to leave the facility.
