



Visitor Screening Questions

Instructions:

Listed below are the campus wide screening questions. If you can answer “yes” to any part of one of the questions, appear visually sick or symptomatic to the screener, or have a temperature above 99°F when we scan your forehead, you will not be permitted to visit.

Questions:

1. Do you have any of the following symptoms: cough, sniffles, sore throat, fever, headache, congestion, body aches, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, NEW loss of taste, or NEW loss of smell?
2. In the past 14 days, have you been around anyone without a mask (at home or in public) who has symptoms of: cough, sniffles, sore throat, fever, headache, congestion, body aches, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, NEW loss of taste, or NEW loss of smell?
3. In the past 14 days, have you traveled OR had contact with anyone who has traveled to an area with a heavy population of coronavirus?
4. In the past 30 days, have you traveled OR had contact with anyone who has traveled outside of the US or on a cruise ship?
5. In the past 14 days, have you worked a job at a nursing facility, assisted living facility, group home, jail, prison, or ICE detention center with positive coronavirus cases?
6. In the past 14 days, have you had contact with anyone who has worked in any facility or business with positive coronavirus cases?
